MRA Auction IX Lot 1: A day for 2 rods on Dorset Frome

LOT 1

A day's fishing on the "Home Beat" on the Dorset Frome for two people, on a day that suits both parties. To be taken by the end of 2016

This is chalk stream paradise.

With a central fishing hut, alfresco dining area and bbq, making it a great beat to fly fish with friends, the fishing hut is next to a pretty bridge pool with plenty of room to relax and enjoy lunch with a glass of wine.

The "Home Beat" makes up a mile of exciting and challenging fly fishing, we also have half a mile of carrier north of the main beat, slightly wilder fishing suitable for those who love to wade.

A great variation of fishing, classic chalk stream features including riffles, pools, plenty of glides and overhanging trees, great sight fishing in crystal clear water.

The fishing is for totally wild Brown Trout and huge Grayling, for which the Frome is famous.

"We have had Grayling to well over FOUR pounds on this beat, and a wild Trout of over SEVEN pounds."

Two dozen barbless river dry flies covering a range of upwings, sedge, and midge. Specifically, CDC & Elks (3x #14, 3x #16), March Brown/Brook Dun Paraduns (6x #14), Olive Paraduns (3x #16, 3x #18), and Quill-Bodied Shuttlecocks (3x #16, 3x #18). These four simple patterns, in their range of sizes, will allow the angler to cover a wide range of upwinged flies, sedges and midges

All patterns are tied on barbless Partridge of Redditch Hooks and utilise Whiting Pro Grade hackles, Nature's Spirit Deer Hair, highest quality CDC and Semperfli fly tying threads.

A rare opportunity to access the lightly fished Bryn Derwen beat at Bettws Newydd. The beat holds trout to over 3lb and there are two named salmon pools.

Trout fishing is best from

April to July and the beat experiences excellent grannom, yellow may dun, danica mayfly and blue-winged olive hatches. The spinner falls and late evening B-WO hatches can be spectacular and this is often the best time to catch a specimen on the surface.

Salmon fishing is most productive from June to September.

The lot is either for a day or two evenings as the guest of Lee Evans. As Lee lives 100m from the beat he is happy to include breakfast, lunch, dinner etc to the winner's preference.

Please note that this part of the river is wide and effective wading can be challenging in high water.
