## Amazing Adaptations

KS1, Lower KS2

5-9 years



### What you need to know:

This week's session looks at how creatures are suited/adapted to survive where they live. In particular it looks at how creatures are able to breathe underwater, how they move, catch/find their food and avoid being eaten by predators.

**Key words:** adaptation, predator, oxygen, gills

- Watch the video clip
- Discuss with the children the amazing adaptations of the river creatures.
- Read through the activity sheet with children.
- Discuss what kind of imaginary creature they will create! Think about how it moves, breathes etc.
