



## Sioni & Sam's Activity sheet: Fishy Food Chains!



Rivers are wonderful but they can be dangerous places, so you need to **THINK SAFETY** and **NEVER** go near water on your own. Healthy rivers are home to lots of wonderful wildlife, all of which is linked together by food chains. All the creatures, predators, prey and grazers in the river all have to find food to survive, every living thing is there can be somebody's meal!
