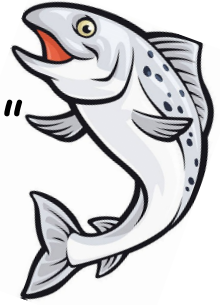




Sioni & Sam's Activity sheet:



"Keep it clean, please don't be mean!"

That's what Sam and Sioni would say if they could talk to us! Our fish friends can only live in clean rivers. If we want to see more of them and other wildlife too, we have to make and keep our rivers clean.

Sometimes rivers get dirty or polluted, but we can do lots to help and make them the perfect place for wildlife.

THINKING & DOING FINS ON!

You'll need: pencils, paper and maybe look at the video clip!

And if you want to try your own filtration experiment: YOU HAVE TO ASK A GROWN UP plus jam jars/see through containers, jug/bottle, kitchen roll, tissues, soil, litter, food dye, oil and a mixing stick

- Can you.....
- Think of 3 things you can do to help keep rivers clean?
You can write them down or draw them
- Imagine you're a fish! Design a poster or write a poem to make people think about rivers, making them realise either: what they put down the drain, or if they don't put litter in bins, these things will end up in rivers and eventually the sea, which is bad for you and for people too!
- Have a go at filtration yourself!

Look at video clip and design your own filtration experiment. You can use all kinds of things with your filters, sand, big stones, small stones, gravel, or use different sizes of sieves. Which do you think will clean the water best? Have a chat with your grown up and record your predictions
