

Sioni & Sam's Activity sheet: Salmon Celebration!



Sioni and Sam love some messy fun! So let your imagination run wild and make the most delightful, dreamiest decorations ever!

Making fins on, time to create your decorations to celebrate our super Atlantic salmon. Before you start making anything ask your grown up if it's Ok and for their help!

You'll need: A GROWN UP! Lots of imagination, some paper, egg boxes, pencils, paint, glue, celery, string, scissors and cocktail sticks.

Now decide which decoration you would like to make!

If it's one of the leaping fish... watch the video again to help you!

If you would like to make a parr-fectly camouflaged salmon hat, just copy or print the template.

Next look up pictures of the salmon when it's a parr or a smolt or an adult.

Then paint or colour the picture of the salmon in the colours which help it to be camouflaged in the same.

Finally, ask an adult to help you cut out your fish, and to attach a paper band to it so it fits your head. Now you are a salmon queen or king!
